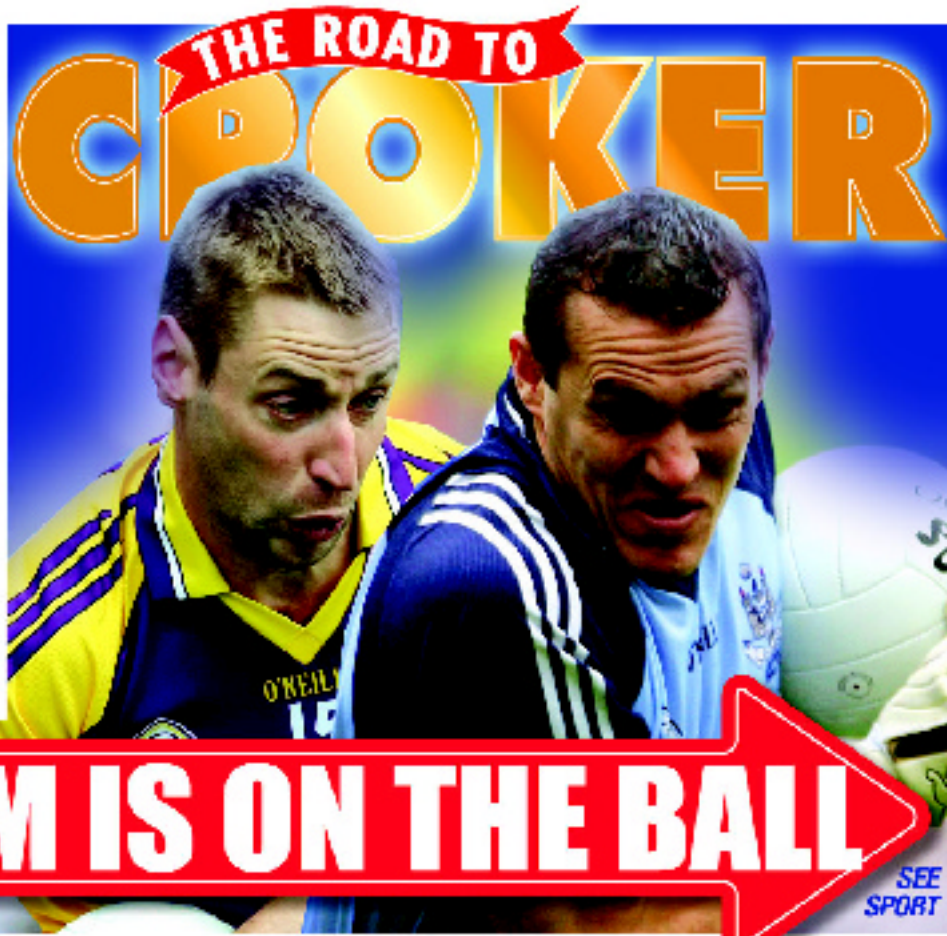

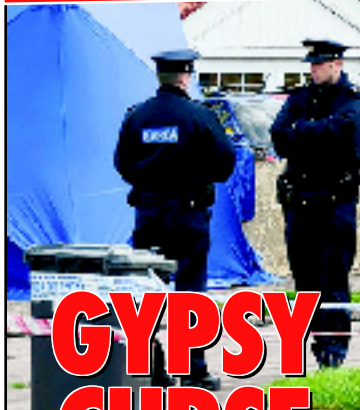

### The €100k summons 'visionary' Christina never saw coming

THIS is the moment visionary Christina Gallagher's House of Prayer came tumbling down. Our undercover reporters observed as the self-styled cult leader was issued with a legal writ demanding the return of €100,000. A second summons was served on her right-hand disciple Fr Gerard McGinnity as the pair celebrated the 15th anniversary of their Achill Island prayer house this week. The court demand has been made by one of the followers who handed large sums of cash to the woman who claims to speak regularly with the Virgin Mary. Furious former devotees of the House want their money back after a Sunday World investigation revealed Gallagher's wealthy lifestyle and portfolio of properties.
